Built in the early 1910's, 2104 Market Street has long existed on the city's major business corridor. Now, as its historic structure is being restored for office use, it makes sense that Brandywine Realty Trust has chosen to use historically rich, reclaimed materials for the renovation.



MULTI-TENANT FLOORS
